

Frankenlust Township Board Meeting  
September 16, 2004

The regular meeting of the Township was called to order by the Supervisor, Hilda Dijak. The pledge was said in unison. Present were Dijak, Revord, Campbell, Anderson, & Appold.

Minutes of the August meeting were approved as printed.

Treasurer's report accepted as presented.

Public input: Bob Klimmick stated he was not against the Saginaw River Project, but was concerned about the waste, in the future years, would our water systems become contaminated. Also would this decrease the value of our land?

Mark Bolt, 7273 Zachary Drive spoke regarding Brookside subdivision concerns, lot Maintenance, development, about drainage, grading, home warranty issues. Vere Jacobs 2221 Mathew Drive spoke on the drainage problem. Supervisor will supply a petition for Brookside subdivision residents to sign to have the Goetz drain cleaned.

Mr. Schauman, the developer, does not inspect the work of the Builder, Mr. Boufford.

Residents from 2229 Ryan Court, 2220 Kara Drive, and others all spoke on the following concerns.

1. Street lighting.
2. Traffic in and out of the subdivision.
3. Weeds on empty lots.
4. Street signs.
5. Basements flooding.
6. Neighborhood Covenants.

Mr. Schauman will have the weeds cut and clean out the road drains. After much discussion, Supervisor stated that these concerns and issues the residents are with Mr. Schauman and Mr. Boufford or an Association organization. She suggested the residents should set a time and meet at the Township Hall to settle these issues.

Fire Department report: August 19 run-s 9 medical, 6 PI/PDA/s, 1 false alarm 1 mutual aid (Kochville), 1 co2 call, YTD 146.

Planning Commission: Land use plan will be back by the end of the month from neighboring communities and forwarded to Planning Commission.

Old Business: Motion by Campbell/ Anderson to adopt a resolution # 2004-04 for a Special assessment district for the construction of a sanitary sewer along Amelith Road, Delta Road, Frankenlust Road, Kloha Road, and Kraenzlein Road Meeting will be October 13, 2004 at 7 P.M. carried full resolution on file.

The total cost of the nature park is \$ 260,000.

Motion by Campbell/Anderson to adopt resolution #2004-05 to approve matching funds of \$ 67,819 ( 26%) carried full resolution on file.

Computer upgrading was discussed. Motion by Dijak/Anderson to upgrade our computer system at the fire Department and the offices with a server and tape backup not to exceed \$ 4000.00 carried.

Motion by Appold/ Anderson to adopt the resolution to pick up the Head lee roll-back motion was defeated.

Motion by Dijak/Campbell to pay bills totaling \$ 49,537.19 carried.
